The particle "ἰδού", from the verb of ὅπασι "to see" occurs 26 times in Revelation

Sometimes used to affirm or validate a statement  
 'Indeed' Rev 1:7, 18, 2:10, 22 3:8, 3:9<sup>2</sup>, 20 5:5  
 9:12, 11:14, 21:3, 5 (used with emphasis on speech, directive)

Also used to draw attention 'look, behold' used in a narrative 4:1, 2, 5:6, 6:2, 5, 8, 12, 7:19 12:13  
 14:1, 14, 15:5, 19:11

Rev 1:7 is clearly a 'rhema' of Daniel 7:13  
and Zech 12

Matt 24:30 has components of Rev 1:7

"And then shall appear the sign of the Son of Man in heaven: and then shall all the tribes of the earth mourn and they shall see the Son of man coming in the clouds of heaven with power and great glory."

What is noteworthy, Zechariah 12:10 is to a limited  
group of individuals vs. Revelation 1:7 which carries  
a universal testimony, "every eye" AND "they also".
