



Strong's Concordance # 3754 that, because, since

- 1) the substance or contents of a statement, used at the beginning of a sentence much like English "quotation marks"
- 2) in elliptical formulas
- 3) the reason why anything is said to be or to be done (because, since, for that, for); causal conjuntion
- 4) it is added to a speaker's words to show what ground he/she gives for his/her opinion

Used as the first word of Colossians 1:16, it assigns the reason or justifies what was previously stated about Christ as "firstborn."

Greek Text Colossians 1:16

ὅτι ἐν αὐτῷ ἐκτίσθη τὰ πάντα ἐν τοῖς οὐρανοῖς καὶ ἐπὶ τῆς γῆς τὰ ὁρατὰ καὶ τὰ ἀόρατα εἴτε θρόνοι εἴτε κυριότητες εἴτε ἀρχαὶ εἴτε ἐξουσίαι τὰ πάντα δι' αὐτοῦ

καὶ είς αὐτὸν ἔκτισται

Ev is the workhorse of prepositions in the New Testament. It occurs 2,752 times, more frequently and more varied than any other.

We can examine ev as:

1) Spatial / sphere: in

2) Temporal: in, within, when, while, during

3) Association: with

4) Cause: because of

5) Instrumental: by, with

6) Reference / Respect: with reference to, with respect to

7) Manner: with

8) Thing possessed: with

9) Standard: according (to the standard)

10) As an equivalent for $\varepsilon i \zeta$ with verbs of motion.
