
Zarah's Line

Bassanus Magnus, king of Sicambri, marries a Norge princess; he is also a priest-king; and also recorded as king of Orkneys?

Clodmir I, king of Sicambri, died 232 BC

Nicanor I, king of Sicambri, marries a princess (British?)

Marcomir II

Clodius I, died 159 BC

Antenor III, king of Sicambri, died 143 BC

Clodmir II, king of Sicambri, died 123 BC

Merodachus, king of Sicambri, died 95 BC

Cassander – son of Merodachus, king of Sicambri, king of the Franks

Antharius, last of the Sicambri kings, died 39 BC

Francus, first king of the Franks (West Franks), died 11 BC

Clodius II, king of the Franks, died 20 AD

Marcomir III, king of the Franks, died 50 AD

Clodomir III, died 63 AD

Antenor IV, died 69 AD

Ratherius (builds Rotterdam), king of the Franks, died 90 AD

Richemer I, king of the Franks, died 114 AD

Odomar marries Ascyla of the Franks, died 128 AD

Marcomir IV marries Athildis. This union will produce a merger with the ancient British line (Judah) from Troas, Aeneas, Brutus to Camber. This line will also produce kings of Hungary and France.

Farabert, king of the Franks, died 186 AD

Sunno, king of the Franks, died 213 AD

Hilderic or Childeric, king of the Franks

Batherus, king of the Franks, died 272 AD

Clodius III, king of the Franks, died 298 AD

Walter, king of the East Franks, died 306 AD

Dagobert, king of the Franks, died 317 AD

Genebald? died 379 AD

Clodius V, died 387 AD

Pharamond or Faramond, king of Westphalia, king of the Merovingians, traditional first king of France, died 428 AD

Clodius, king of Westphalia, married Basina of Thuringia, died 448 AD

Sigmerius I

Ferreolus, died 529 AD

Asbertus or Ansbertus, died 570 AD

Arnulphus, died 601 AD

Pepin of Heristal, de facto ruler of Francia, married a noblewoman, Alpaida

Charles Martel, de facto ruler of Francia, also known as the Hammer, died 741 AD

Pepin the Short, also known as Pepin the Younger, king of the Franks, first Carolingian to become king

Charlemagne, or Charles the Great, king of the Lombards, first emperor of the Romans from 800 AD, died 814 AD
