Septuagint (LXX) κατὰ τὴν τάξιν Μελχισεδέκ
 “according to the order of Melchizedek”

The following verses help us understand the use of τάξιν or τάξις in the New Testament:

Luke 1:8–9 “And it came to pass, that while he (Zacharias) executed the priest’s office before God in the order of his course, according the custom of the priest’s office...”
 ↓
 τάξει – RSV translated “succession”

1 Corinthians 14:40 “Let all things be done decently and in order.” → καὶ κατὰ τάξιν γινέσθω
 “according to order let it be done.”

Colossians 2:5 “. . . joying and beholding your order . . .”

- Hebrews 5:6 “Thou art a priest for ever after the order of Melchisedec.”
 5:10 “Called of God an high priest after the order of Melchisedec.”
 6:20 “after the order of Melchisedec.”
 7:11 “after the order of Melchisedec, and not be called after the order of Aaron?”
 7:21 “Thou art a priest for ever after the order of Melchisedec.”

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There are nine Hebrew words in the LXX translated by the one Greek word, τάξις:
