

Spirit / *pneuma*

Galatians 5:16

VIPA--XS CC N·DN·S (verb·imperative·present·active) 2pp
 VMPA--YP CC NAFS
Λέγω δέ πνεύματι περιπατεῖτε καὶ ἐπιθυμίαν
 I say but (by) Spirit walk and lust

NGFS AB AB (verb·subjunctive·aorist·active) 2pp
 VSAA--YP
σαρκὸς οὐ μὴ τελέσητε
 of flesh not (by no means) could you complete

Galatians 5:25

CS VIPA--YP NDNS NDNS AB (verb·subjunctive·present·active) 1pp
 VSPA--XP
εἰ ζῶμεν πνεύματι πνεύματι καὶ στοιχῶμεν
 If we live (by) Spirit (by) Spirit also (let) us be in line (with)

KJV Galatians 5:16 –This I say then, Walk in the Spirit, and ye shall not fulfill the lust of the flesh.

KJV Galatians 5:25 – If we live in the Spirit, let us also walk in the Spirit.

A look at the πνευμα/pneuma related words in Galatians

Galatians 3:2 “Received ye the Spirit by the works of the law, or by the hearing of faith?”
 (3:2 πνεῦμα - NOUN·ACCUSATIVE·NEUTUR·SINGULAR)

3:3 “Having begun in the Spirit, are ye now made perfect by the flesh?”
 (3:3 πνεύματι - NOUN·DATIVE·NEUTUR·SINGULAR)

3:5 “He that ministereth to you the Spirit, and worketh miracles among you, doeth he it by the works of the law or by the hearing of faith?”
 (3:5 πνευμα - NOUN·ACCUSATIVE·NEUTUR·SINGULAR)

3:14 “That we might receive the promise of the Spirit through faith.”
 (3:14 πνευματος - NOUN·GENITIVE·NEUTUR·SINGULAR)

4:6 “God hath sent forth the Spirit of his Son into your hearts...”
 (4:6 NANS)

4:29 “He that was born after the flesh persecuted him after the Spirit, even so now.”
 (4:29 NANS)

5:5 “For we through the Spirit wait for the hope of righteousness by faith.”
 (5:5 NDNS)

5:16 “This I say then, walk in the Spirit, and ye shall not fulfill the lust of the flesh.”
 (5:16 NDNS)

Until a “genesis”* of the Spirit is in the believer Spirit cannot be “the Subject” of warfare—Flesh vs. Spirit.

5:17 “For the flesh lusteth against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh...”
 a (5:17 NGNS) b (5:17 NNNS)

5:18 “But if ye be led of the Spirit, ye are not under the law.”
 (5:18 NGNS)

Spirit / *pneuma*

Galatians 5:22 “But the fruit of the Spirit is love...”
(5:22 NGNS)

5:25 “If we live in the Spirit, let us also walk in the Spirit.”
(5:25 NDNS) (5:25 NDNS)

6:1 “Brethren, if a man be overtaken in a fault, ye which
are spiritual, restore such a one in the Spirit of meekness...”
(6:1 A--NM-P) (6:1 NDNS)

6:8 “But he that soweth to the Spirit shall of the Spirit reap life everlasting.”
(6:8 NANS) (6:8 NGNS)

6:18 “Brethren, the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with your spirit. Amen.”
(6:18 NGNS)

Every occurrence of *πνευμα* (and related) (except Galatians 6:1) NOUNS, ALL NEUTER AND SINGULAR AND ONLY THE CASE CHANGES:

5 times = ACCUSATIVE

6 times = DATIVE

6 times = GENITIVE

2 times = NOMINATIVE ← Usually used as the subject
